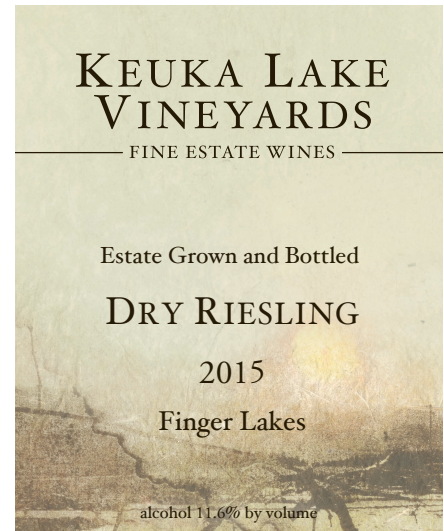

Vinification

Evergreen Lek
Hand harvested
Settled in tank for 24 hours
Racked, inoculated with X5
36-day fermentation at 52°F

Eastside Upper
Hand harvested
Settled outside for 24 hours
Racked, inoculated with RHST
19-day fermentation at 52°F

Ernesto Lucie
Hand harvested
Settled outside for 24 hours
Racked, inoculated with RHST
23-day fermentation at 52°F

Aged on fermentation lees for 8 months until blending
No fining agents used
Vegan friendly
Sterile filtered at bottling

Vineyards

The Evergreen Lek Vineyard is one of our oldest Riesling sites, with just over 1 ½ acres planted in 1999. In 2015, 1 acre of terraces were added to extend the vineyard down the hill. The site is made of soils mixed of slate and glacial deposits, bringing a unique minerality to the wines produced from this site. The Eastside Upper Vineyard is two acres of our farthest eastern Riesling vineyard, made of mostly clay sediments with dense glacial till. The Ernesto Lucie Vineyard is just opposite the road to the Evergreen Lek Vineyard on the Westside of the lake. Although these sites are only 20-feet apart, they could not be more different. Ernesto Lucie is still predominately loam-based with small stone fragments but not as steeply-sloped as its neighbor.
